Invasive Weed Control Internship

Invasive Weed Control Intern will work with a team in the maintenance and restoration of prairie sites in the South Puget Sound region of Washington, primarily on Joint Base Lewis McChord.

The position entails strenuous physical activity and potential operation of heavy equipment.
