## **Notice of Determination of Nonsignificance**

June 26, 2018

Notice is hereby given that the Department of Veterans Affairs, acting as SEPA lead agency under RCW 43.21C, issued a Determination of Nonsignificance (DNS) under the State Environmental Policy Act Rules (Chapter 197-11 WAC) for the following proposal:

Orting Veterans Village - The proposal involves the leasing of land for and the construction of the Orting Veterans Village, which will consist of 35 cottages and a community building serving as a permanent supportive housing for veterans without homes. The cottages range from 176 sf to 256 sf for accessible units and contain a bedroom, sink, toilet, and shower. The 2,700 sf community building includes a common kitchen, dining room, living room, restrooms, a laundry facility, staff offices and a multipurpose room. There will be a community garden and common green space on site.

Location of Proposal: An approximately 5.24 acre area on the grounds of the Washington Soldiers Home – 1301 Orting Kapowsin Highway, Orting, Washington 98360.

Lead Agency: Department of Veterans Affairs has determined that this proposal will not have a probable significant adverse impact on the environment. An environmental impact statement (EIS) is not required under RCW 43.21C.030(2)(c). We have reviewed the attached Environmental Checklist along with the Phase I and Phase II Environmental Assessments, Traffic Study, and Soil and Groundwater characterization.
