The Washington Veterans Home was founded in 1910 to serve Veterans in need who had served in the Civil War. Veterans continue to be served at a state of the art care center providing comprehensive medical, nursing, psychiatric/psychosocial, rehabilitative and restorative care.

A multidisciplinary therapeutic and clinical approach is used to treat Veterans' complex physical, psychological and psychosocial conditions. The home's highly skilled team, in addition to addressing an individual's direct care needs, is also focused on fostering the quality of life and overall well-being of veterans served. These efforts involve the provision of quality medical, nursing, pharmacological, psychiatric/psychosocial, dementia, rehabilitative/restorative, and nutritional care. Psychosocial support is provided in a safe, pleasant home-like environment. An array of life-enriching opportunities responsive to individual's abilities, interests and desires are available.

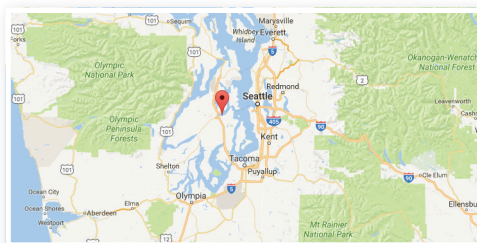
A dedicated care staff includes knowledgeable and skilled individuals who are committed to meeting the needs and desires of those who served, while also advancing their quality of life and overall well-being.

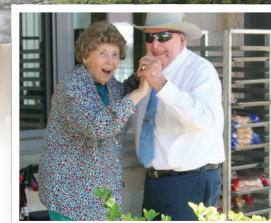
Established in 1910, the Washington Veterans Home, in Port Orchard is on a 31 acre bluff overlooking Puget Sound.

The Washington Veterans Home provides quality nursing and managed care services.

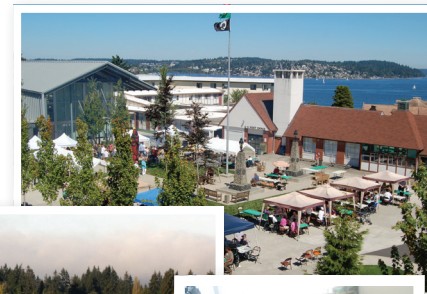

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for admission, Veterans must need nursing home care and meet the following criteria:

- Served in the United States uniformed services, including National Guard;
- Meet discharge requirements (see [HTTPS://dva.wa.gov/Definition-Veteran](https://dva.wa.gov/Definition-Veteran));
- Reside in Washington State;
- Be the spouse of a Resident or widow of an eligible Veteran;
- or be a Gold Star Parent.
