To be eligible for admission, applicants must need nursing home care and meet the following criteria:

-Served at any time, in any branch of the United States Armed Forces;
-Received an honorable discharge;
-Reside in Washington State;
-Be the spouse or widow of an eligible veteran;
-Or be a Gold Star Parent.

-Veterans rated 70%-100% Service Connected Disabled, or whose service conected disability is the reason nursing care is needed, may have their nursing home care paid by the Federal VA.
