We are so excited to share news about the new NAC (Nursing Assistant Certified) Training Programs that are becoming available across the WDVA!

WDVA took the question of *What do we do when we don't have enough NAC applicants to fill vacancies?* and found a solution: **train our own!** This new and creative approach to NAC recruitment means we'll have new NACs who are trained from the very beginning in the WDVA Way. The training is at no cost to the new NAC, and they are hired by WDVA as a NAR (Nursing Assistant Registered) where they spend time learning the basics while working on the floor with experienced WDVA NACs! We are already seeing the result with a newly trained team of NACs who are ready to pitch in and serve alongside our other WDVA staff members!


State Veterans Cemetery in Medical Lake to Hold Committal Service for over 100 Veterans on November 16

Over the coming days unclaimed Veterans remains from throughout the state will be escorted to the Washington State Veterans Cemetery, Medical Lake where the cremains will be ceremoniously turned over to the Department of Veterans Affairs for interment. These individuals will be interred in their final resting place with full military honors following a community committal service.

The committal service will take place at **1:00pm** on **Wednesday November 16**, **2022**, and is open to the public. This will be the largest number of unclaimed or abandoned remains received by WDVA for interment at one time. It may also be the largest in the nation for the Missing in America Project (501c3), who partnered in the research effort with WDVA and Dignity Memorial. As a reminder, pets or the use of any tobacco or vaping products are not allowed on the premises.

HB1181 tasked WDVA to create and maintain a resource database for Service Members, Veterans, and Military Families in Washington State. Emblems cost \$18 and can be placed on any passenger vehicle, truck, and large trailer license plate, including special and personalized plates.

Ten dollars from the purchase of each emblem is deposited into the Veteran and Military Member Suicide Prevention Account. Grants from this account will be available to community organizations who provide suicide prevention, peer support, and other assistance to at-risk and transitioning veteran, military members, and their families.

The Washington State Department of Veterans Affairs (WDVA) was inducted into the Department of Defense's Military Spouse Employment Partnership (MSEP) on October 25th as part of 70 new government, nonprofit, and private employers. As part of this new cohort, WDVA joins more than 600 organizations committed to recruiting, hiring, promoting, and retaining military spouses.

The Undersecretary of Defense for Personnel and Readiness, Gilbert R. Cisneros Jr., welcomed the new companies into the partnership during an induction ceremony at the three-day MSEP Engage 2022 event held in Northern Virginia in late October.
