
Program Highlight

The WDVA Homeless Veterans Reintegration Program (HVRP) is a proven, successful program that gets homeless veterans off the street and back to being productive members of society. WDVA provides HVRP services to Veterans in King, Kitsap, Mason, Pierce, Clark, Thurston, Lewis, Yakima, Spokane, Stevens, Pend O'reille, Ferry, Grant, Adams, Lincoln, and Whitman Counties.

The HVRP offers a structured, individually designed case management plan to assist veterans become employable and secure.
